



SEX WISE DISTRIBUTION OF COVID-19 CASES (TOTAL=14046)




COVID-19 Cases details (Cumulative):

Now, Testing sites in All provinces - 22 in total week 27 (0 added)




NUMBER OF PCRTESTS AND POSITIVE RESULTS FOR COVID-19/WEEK

- ✓ Phase 1: KN95 mask (1150 pcs), Boot with cover (440 pairs), Hand sanitizer (2500 pcs), Soap (15118 pcs) and Sodium Hypochlorite (450 pcs)

□ Risk Communication/Community Awareness

- Radio program on mental health 'Jiwan Rakchhya' broadcasted through 300 radio stations
- Radio messages are being broadcasted through more than 500 radio stations
- A number of radio/television interviews, news paper articles have been published
- ☐ Tele-mental Health and service from helpline (last 2 weeks)
 - Counselling and Psychological support: 1,557
- ☐ Mental Health and Psychosocial Support to persons in isolation and quarantine
 - Psychological First Aid: 7015
 - Quarantine centers visited:318
- ☐ Mental Health and Psychosocial Support to the communities
 - Education/Counselling/Psychological First Aid: 952
