




GNI Introduction


- □ GNI has been working in Nepal since 2002.
- Implementing projects in one metropolis, 21 municipalities and 29 rural municipalities of 19 districts.
- Target Beneficiaries:
 - 20,828 Sponsored Children (boys 9,393 and girls 11,435) and their parents;
 - 459 schools
 - 282 Health Facilities
 - 114 Cooperatives
 - 194 Child Clubs
 - 89,529 females and 69,024 males benefited






