




TREND OF COVID CASES IN PROVINCE TWO (ACCUMULATED)



INCLINATION OF COVID-19 CASES/ WEEK




TREND OF PEOPLE IN QUARANTINE CENTERS






NO OF PEOPLE IN ISOLATION




COVID CASES BY AGE GROUP (20 MAY 2020)

KEY ACHIEVEMENTS

- OPD services, essential services, immunization and nutrition services resumed at all levels
- Case investigation and contact tracing going well
- Logistics are in proper operation (PCR machines, ventilators and including COIVD logistics will be procured soon)
- Health sector preparedness plan for monsoon is under discussion with MoSD and other stakeholders
- Information management related to COIVD-19 going well.

WAYFORWARDS...

- Strengthen laboratory capacity at provincial hospital and at GNS Hospital at RJB including skilled HR,
- PCR is under disorder at JPR Hospital
- HR planning is underway of development
- Quarantine center sanitation improvement with basic facilities
- Intensify case investigation and contact tracing by enhancing laboratory testing with PCR.
- Isolation ward improvement and increase number of bed facilities
- Strengthen transportation/ referral services for COVID-19 suspects
- Psychosocial experts to be mobilized to resolve stigma and promote mental health well being
- Abundant supply of PPE, Masks, sanitizers, and VTM
- DPHO empowered with hierarchial power, budget and vehicles, etc
