





Support from Global Fund (under Save the Children, Nepal) for COVID-19 Response in Nepal



PPE and IPC items

- ➤ Following commodities procured through Global Fund handed over to MoHP on May 3, 2020; Hand sanitizer (500ml) 2500 bottles, Non-sterile examination gloves 53000 pairs, Sterile examination gloves 2000 pairs, Scrub tops, scrub pants, gown, biohazard bag each 800 pcs, KN95 mask 7000 pcs and IR thermometer 100 pcs.
- ➤ 28 sets of PPE (including N95 masks) handed over to Seti provincial hospital, via Provincial Health Logistics Management Center (PHLMC), Dhangadhi
- > 1000 units of hand sanitizer given to Gandaki Pradesh PHD
- > 29 PPE set with N95 masks handed over to Provincial Health Directorate, Province 3.
- ➤ For National TB program (DR centre) in Province 5, 500 pcs of KN95 mask, 2000 surgical masks and 1000 disposable gloves were given
- > 500 pcs of KN95 mask provided to National Tuberculosis Centre (NTC), Bhaktapur.

Medical equipment

- 20 pulse oximeters and 40 digital thermometers given to Bheri Hospital
- ➤ 2 cardiac monitors, 3 electric suction machines, and 1 ECG machine given to the Lumbini Provincial Hospital, Butwal to prepare the isolation ward for COVID-19 response
- ➤ 33 patient beds with mattresses and 1 cardiac monitor given to Koshi hospital.
- ➤ 1 medical double fly tent of 40 sq. meter given to Sukra Raj Tropical and Infectious disease hospital, Teku.
- 3 cardiac monitors to Janakpur Provincial hospital
- ➤ 800 pcs of bed nets provided to Province 5 government to use in quarantine facilities.



Laboratory equipment

- One micro-centrifuge machine was handed over to Provincial Public Health laboratory (PPHL) Province 5, which will be used for sample processing for COVID -19 testing.
- One biosafety cabinet given to Sukra Raj Tropical and Infectious disease hospital, Teku.
- 5530 SARS-CoV-2 GeneXpert cartridges were handed over to National Tuberculosis Control Center. These cartridges will be used for diagnosis of COVID-19 using already existing GeneXpert laboratories in Nepal. GeneXpert technology requires minimal skills and can provide SARS-CoV-2 PCR results within 45 minutes.



Food and nutrition support

- ➤ Food and nutrition support package for two months provided for 668 ultra-poor children living with HIV (under 12 years) and 732 ultra-poor PLHIV above 45 years, through National Association of People Living with HIV/AIDS in Nepal (NAPN). Each of the 1400 beneficiaries got package worth of 1650 NPR.
- ➢ Global Fund supported "Recovering Nepal" to provide food and nutrition package (for 2 weeks) to 3000 people who inject drugs (PWIDs) and People living with HIV (PLHIVs) residing in 95 care centres throughout Nepal.
- Save the Children, Global fund funded Key Population Research and Advocacy Project supported National Association of People Living with HIV [NAP+N] to provide essential food items to 636 Children living with HIV in 46 districts of Nepal. For the safety of community workers during distribution, PPE items [500 ml sanitizer, 30 pair of single use non-sterile gloves and 30 facemasks] for each district was provisioned.

 - 22 electronic suction devices
 - Supportive treatment equipment: Laryngoscope (30), ET tubes and accessories (50), nasal prongs (300), oxygen masks (300)
 - 8 ICU beds, 6 bed screens,
 - 11 oxygen concentrators, 120 pulse oximeters
 - 171 IR thermometers, 76 electronic BP machines
- > PPE items
 - 3810 full PPE sets and 1950 N95 masks to provincial governments
