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Major Highlights (3-5 bullets)

- Supply super cereal to Makawanpur, Chitwan and Dhading and the transportation from UNICEF
- 2627 G1000Days household received nutrition package from local level
- With the support from Suaahara II, Bhanchhin Ama, Nutrition BCC and Covid prevention messages are been aired regularly by 14 FMs and Radio Nepal.
- Regular phone follow up by Suaahara team to SAM and MAM children HHs.
- Risk communication (phone counselling, SMS) continued from Suaahara program. Till date- Total: 2,80,148, Pregnant-19,198 and Lactating Mothers-79,538 have been counseled on COVID and Nutrition.
