
Caste-based discrimination

Caste-based discrimination is the discrimination perpetuated by high caste groups on lower caste groups on the basis of caste, which leads to oppression and exploitation.

"There should be no discrimination based on caste. However, our parents say that Dalit should be restricted from coming to our house. It's not just our parents, the whole community is doing this, so how can it be wrong?"









Although the legal age for marriage in Nepal is 20 years, the definition of child marriage applies for children up to 18 years of age.






